**From Cattle Property to Cyber Corridor Exhibitions
Contemporary Landscape Artist, Annabel Tully of Queensland's Channel Country,
Selected to be featured artist in the "Out of Australia"**

Capturing the vast skies and landscapes of rural Australia is routine for award winning contemporary landscape artist, Annabel Tully. Going global through Cyber Corridors as a featured artist in the "Out of Australia" series was unexpected.

"Unexpected for Annabel, perhaps, but not to those who witness her talent," commented Professor Nell Arnold, author of the "Out of Australia" series. "Annabel's work features the land she has come to love and understand, an arid land where sky and desert meet in a mirage and where even the word "vast" is inadequate in description."

What does going "Cyber Corridor" mean? Annabel's landscapes are already housed in two Queensland galleries and also on her own website (www.annabeltully.com). The invitation from the **Out of Australia** series extends Annabel's reach through a network of galleries and associations around the world that recognise people of insight and inspiration.

"Annabel's story would appear to be quiet – a school teacher, principal, artist. Then you add the landscape of acres stretching by the thousand, distancing a cattle and sheep property into isolation. Challenges to enterprise compounded by drought, and yet with spirit of sharing, Annabel and her husband Steve open

their property to host an arts camp, hosting artists and those who would try to stretch the lens and canvas around expansive reach of rive gum trees. Land without borders and skies with no understanding of limitation – in this vastness of isolated Australia, a woman paints.”

“We are proud to announce this Cyber Corridor Exhibition featuring Annabel’s work and story.” Professor Arnold continued, “We anticipate this is only the beginning of a global corridor adventure. International poet, Melanie Simms contacted us to organise a collaboration, a book of poetry to be illustrated by Annabel remembering the spirit of adventure and courage in uncharted seas, deserts and skies.”

Annabel is also being invited to be a major contributor in a multi-media trilogy with Major Chad Sherrin and Professor Arnold whose work features the poems of warriors for peace in “Till Stars Again.” Inspired by the rains that have reached even the arid lands of south west Queensland, Annabel is painting her own new series on creation and the re-energising processes in life as she witness the land recovering and re-generation.

All three series will be hosted in galleries and art books in both Australia and the United States of America in 2011.
